



Forest Careers Video Contest

Students ages 14-18 years from Washington, Oregon, Idaho or Montana are invited to participate in this contest. Students may submit video entries as individuals or work with other students in a team.

In 90 seconds, provide information about the value of one or more jobs in the forest sector in a way that is accurate, original and creative. Videos should be well researched, and utilize information from at least one interview with a forest sector professional. Interviews may be in-person or virtual.

Prior to beginning work on a video, review the *Contest Rules*, the *Judging Criteria* and the *Information for Students* provided on the website. Remember: release forms are required for anyone whose face or voice appears in the video, the individual or team who creates the video, and their parents/guardians. All forms are included under the *Forms* link on the website.

Use the links on the website to begin your research—as well as to help you find individuals to interview. Read through the interview tips and notes for making a successful video for helpful pointers.

Make sure to download and complete all the necessary forms. There is an entry checklist form that will help you make sure that all the required information is at your fingertips when you are ready to enter your video into the contest.

For the 2023 contest, entries must be received by April 7. Winners will be announced May 1.
